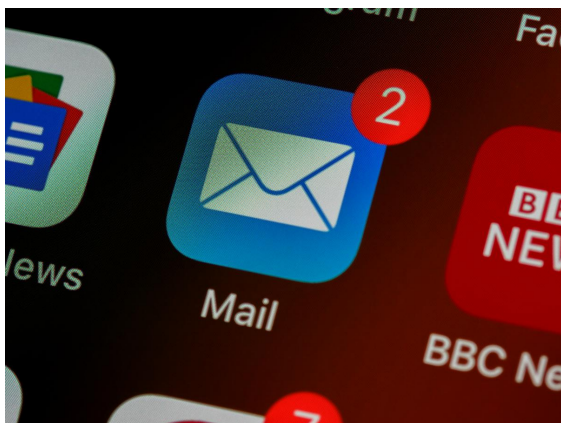


Cybersecurity Corner

Amazon has reported an increase in customers reporting fake emails about Amazon Prime membership subscriptions. Scammers are sending fake emails claiming your Amazon Prime subscription will automatically renew at an unexpected price. They may include personal information in order to appear legitimate. The email will include links that take you to a fake website where they can steal your Amazon login credentials and banking information.

If you receive an email like this and would like to verify your Prime membership, use your Amazon mobile app or go directly to Amazon.com. To find out if a message is really from Amazon, visit the Message Center under “Your Account.” Legitimate messages from Amazon will appear there. As an extra layer of security you can enable two-step verification for your account through the Login & Security settings page. You can report suspicious communications at the link below.
