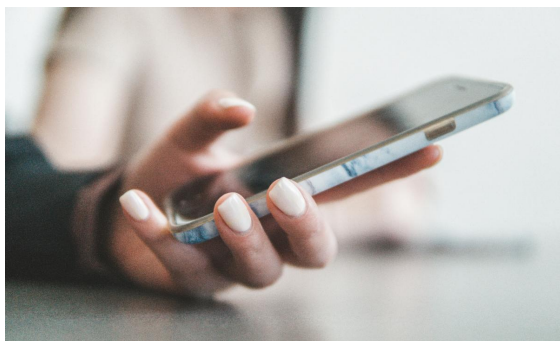


Cybersecurity Corner

You may receive a call or voicemail regarding a loan you don't recall applying for. Scammers are hoping you will respond first and think later. This is one of many different types of phone scams.

It could begin with the scammer calling to say you are "prequalified" for a loan. This will segue into them asking for personal information like your social security number or bank account numbers. They may say the "loan application" is almost finished but they need a few more details from you. Or maybe they will pressure you by saying, "I hope you don't miss out". In a voicemail, the caller might offer to take you off the call list...if you then call back, (another pressure tactic.)

Scammers will often make these "urgent" calls multiple times a day from different numbers. But don't respond — not even to "opt out." If you're getting calls like these on your cell phone never call back, don't trust caller ID, and block the number.
