

Cybersecurity Corner

You're probably signed up for at least one kind of rewards program through a store or restaurant. These programs can be useful by giving coupons and sometimes free items based on how many points you earn. Unfortunately, scammers try to take advantage of this by sending phishing messages about points expiring. They'll say you need to click on a link to save your points or they'll expire today. But if you click, they'll try to steal your personal information or download harmful software on your phone.

If you get a text like this, don't click on any links within it. Go to the company's app or website and log in to see if you have any points that are actually expiring. If you get a phishing text, report it as spam or junk on your phone. Make sure your phone's software is updated regularly to best protect against security threats.
